Many of the members took his card so they could give him a call for those types of smaller projects. He has done a lot of work with Mopars and Cougars. James and Cheryl had a building with several of their own collectible cars, but, alas, he seems to get to those last (the cobbler's kids always need new shoes, you know??).
