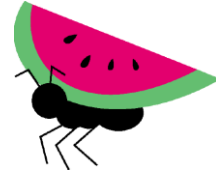

The club will provide hamburgers, condiments, and drinks.

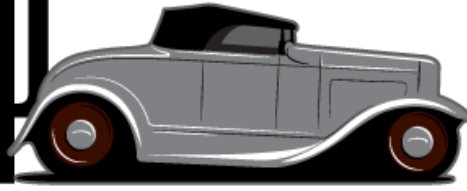
Please bring a side dish, salad, or dessert, and don't forget your chairs!

All Early Ford V8 club members are welcome!

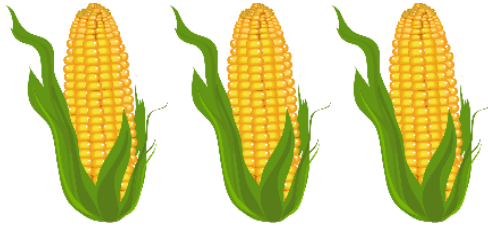
