SHOW REQUIREMENTS

1. **Car Show Hours:**

Friday, June 23	5:00pm - 9:00pm
Saturday, June 24	10:00am - 7:00pm
Sunday, June 25	11:00am - 6:00pm

Award Ceremony will take place at 5:00pm on Sunday. Participating cars may exit the facility after 6:00pm upon notification.

- Car Check-in Time:**

Thursday, June 22	8:00am - 9:00pm
Friday, June 23	8:00am - 10:00am

All cars must be parked inside by 10:00am, June 23. No exceptions.

2. Judges has the right to change the class of a vehicle if it isn't in the correct classification.
3. Official Event lanyard is required throughout the event.
4. Once vehicle is parked on the show field it must stay parked till the end of the event. Vehicle owners will be notified at 6 pm on Sunday (June 25) when it's safe to exit the facility.
5. No running or revving engines during show hours.
6. No pop-up tents on show field.
7. Please be careful around cars to prevent door nicks and belt buckle scratches.
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification.

CAR SHOW JUDGING DETAILS

1. All Cars will be judged for workmanship, cleanliness and condition only. Cars will NOT be judged on authenticity.
2. Judging will start 10:00 AM or upon announcement by Head Judge.
3. To be ready for the judging of your vehicle:
 - Doors should be closed but unlocked
 - Trunks or hatches open
 - Hoods up
 - Maintain your vehicle in its assigned parking place
 - Once the judging has started, stand off to the side and make yourself available to respond to requests from the judging team and to open doors, etc.
4. Cars will be Judged within their Class and Best in Class vehicles will receive a Route 66 Road Fest Trophy.
5. A "BEST IN SHOW" award will be given by AAA.
6. The Award Ceremony will be on Sunday at 5:00pm and the event ends at 6:00pm.
